

Important Guidelines

Booking Adventures at Loch Park

The following guidelines have been written to assist group leaders in organising and booking adventures at Loch Park Adventure Centre.

We try to be as flexible as possible to suit individual groups aims and objectives, however, we have found that due to an increase in bookings there are areas where we have had to be more specific in the details of individual bookings.

- The duration of a full day adventure is approximately 5 hours between 10.00am until 4.00pm (1 hour lunch break).
- The duration of a half day adventure is approximately 2½ hours between 10.00am until 12.30pm or 1.30pm until 4.00pm.
- Group numbers cannot exceed 8 persons. Large groups will be split into smaller groups of 8.
- Accompanying group leaders (for young persons groups) will be permitted free of charge at a ratio of 1:8. Excess leaders will be considered part of the group if they are participating.
- Loch Park Adventure Centre provide wetsuits for wet activities.
- Please refer to the 'What to Bring' list for the groups comfort.
- Unaccompanied groups will be supervised at all times by a member of staff at Loch Park.
- It is normal practice for the organising body to have organised parental consent before arriving at Loch Park.
- If the group participate in more than 4 activities, a certificate is available at no extra cost. A list of group names should be given to the Senior Instructor on arrival if you require certificates.
- A booking form must be returned to confirm a booking.
- Loch Park Adventure Centre Instructors must be used for all wet activities (kayaking, canoeing, gorge walking and raft building) also archery with organised groups.

Please note the Bunkhouse has to be vacated between the hours of 10.00 am and 4.00 pm unless prior arrangements made with the Centre.

We trust that the above guidelines will result in a more quality experience and a higher level of customer care.
